~~AN ACT RESPECTING THE REMISSION OF CERTAIN PENALTIES.~~

(Assented to

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Lieutenant Governor in Council may remit penalties.

1. The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall have power at any time to remit any pecuniary penalty or forfeiture imposed by any Ordinance of the North-West Territories, or by an Act of the Legislature of the Province of Alberta, in whole or in part, unless the same is imposed by "An Ordinance respecting the Legislative Assembly of the Territories" or by some Ordinance or Act respecting elections of members of the Legislative Assembly, or is recoverable in respect of an offence committed in connection with an election of a member of the said Assembly.

Statement to be submitted to Legislative Assembly.

2. A detailed statement of all remissions made under the authority of the last preceding section shall be submitted to the Legislative Assembly within the first fifteen days of the next ensuing session thereof.
