An Act respecting Partnerships.

(Assented to

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

#### REGISTRATION OF COPARTNERSHIPS.

1. All persons associated in partnership for trading, manu-pecharations facturing or mining purposes in the province shall cause to to be filed in be filed in the office of the registration clerk of the registration certain cases district for registration of chattel mortgages and other transfers of personal property in the province, in which they carry on or intend to carry on business, a declaration in writing, signed by the several members of such partnership:

Provided, however, that if any of the said members be absent Where parties from the place where they carry on or intend to carry on business at the time of making such declaration, then such declaration shall be signed by the members present, in their own names and also for their absent co-members, under their special authority to that effect; such special authority to be at the same time filed with the said registration clerk and annexed to such declaration.

- 2. Such declaration shall be in the form A in the schedule Contents of to this Act, and shall contain the names, surnames, additions and residences of each and every partner or associate as aforesaid, and the name, style or firm under which they carry on or intend to carry on such business, and stating also the time during which the partnership has existed and is to exist, also declaring that the persons therein named are the only members of such copartnership or association.
- 3. Such declaration shall be filed within six months next Time for filing after the formation of, any such partnership and a similar

Every person engaged in business for trading, manu-individual facturing or mining purposes, and who is not associated in using trade partnership with any other person or persons, but who uses as his business style some name or designation other than his own, or who in such business uses his own name with the addition of "and company" or some other word or phrase indicating a plurality of members in the firm, shall cause to be filed, as aforesaid, a declaration of the fact in writing, signed by such person.

after the formation of any such partnership and a similar declaration shall in like manner be filed when and so often as Changes in the firm hange or alteration of partnership takes place in the firm under which they intend to carry on business or in the place of residence of each member of said firm, and every new declaration shall state the alteration in the partnership.

## PERSON USING TRADE NAME. REGISTRATION.

4. Every person engaged in business for trading, manu-individual facturing or mining purposes, and who is not associated in name partnership with any other person or persons, but who uses as his business style some name or designation other than his own, or who in such business uses his own name with the addition of "and company" or some other word or phrase indicating a plurality of members in the firm, shall cause to be filed, as aforesaid, a declaration of the fact in writing, signed by such person.

5. The declaration last aforesaid shall contain the name, Contents of surname, addition and residence of the person making the declaration same, and the name, style or firm under which he carries on or intends to carry on business, and shall also state that no other person is associated with him in partnership, and the same shall be filed within six months of the time when such style is first used,

#### REGISTRATION BOOKS.

- 6. It shall be the duty of the registration clerk aforesaid Registration to keep two alphabetical index books of all declarations of copartnership filed in his office, in pursuance of the provisions hereof.
- 7. In one of such books, hereinafter called the "firm index book," the registration clerk shall enter in alphabetical order the style of the respective firms in respect of which declarations have been filed in his office, and shall place opposite each entry the names of the person or persons composing such firm, and the date of the receipt by him of the declaration in the manner shown in form B in the schedule to this Act.
- 8. In the second of such books, hereinafter called the "indi-Individual vidual index book," the said registration clerk shall enter in alphabetical order the names of the respective members of each of such firms, and shall place opposite such entry the style of the firm of which such person is a member, and the date of the receipt of the declaration in the manner shown in form C in the schedule to this Act.

### PENALTY FOR NONREGISTRATION.

9. Each and every member of any partnership or other Failure to persons required to register a declaration under the provisions Act of this Act, who fails to comply with the requirements aforesaid, shall forfeit the sum of one hundred dollars to be recovered before any court of competent jurisdiction by any person suing as well on his own behalf, as on behalf of His Majesty; and half of such penalty shall belong to the general revenue fund of the province, and the other half to the party suing for the same, unless the suit be brought as it may be by the Attorney General on behalf of His Majesty only, in which case the whole of the penalty shall belong to the province aforesaid.

## EFFECT OF DECLARATION.

- 10. The allegations made in the declaration aforesaid cannot Binding be controverted by any person who has signed the same, nor declaration can they be controverted as against any party not being a partner by a person who has not signed the same, but who was really a member of the partnership therein mentioned at the time such declaration was made.
- 11. Until a new declaration is made and filed by him or by Liability of his co-partners or any of them as aforesaid, no such signer declaration. shall be deemed to have ceased to be a partner; but nothing Failure to herein contained shall exempt from liability any person who, declare does being a partner, fails to declare the same, as already provided, from liability and such person may, notwithstanding such omission, be sued jointly with the partners mentioned in the declaration, or they may be sued alone, and if judgment is recovered against them any other partner or partners may be sued jointly or severally

in an action on the original cause of action upon which Partners' rights such judgment was rendered; nor shall anything in this Act inter se be construed to affect the rights of any partners with regard to each other, except that no such declaration as aforesaid shall be controverted by any signer thereof.

#### DECLARATION OF DISSOLUTION.

12. Upon the dissolution of any partnership any or all of Declaration of the persons who compose such partnership may sign and file a declaration certifying the dissolution of the partnership in the form D in the schedule to this Act.

#### REGISTRATION FEES.

13. The said registration clerk shall be entitled for filing a rees declaration under this Act, to a fee of fifty cents, and for searches made in each of such books the following fees and no more:
