AN ACT RESPECTING THE IMPERIAL DEBTORS' ACT OF 1869.

(Assented to

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Act of the Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, known as ~~the~~ Debtors' Act, 1869, and being Chapter 62 of 32 and 33 Victoria, shall not be in force or effect in the Province of Alberta, from and after the date of the coming into force of this Act.

2. Nothing herein contained shall be taken to imply or to mean that the said Debtors' Act has been in force in the Province, prior to the date of the coming into force of this Act; nor shall the passage of this Act in any way affect any proceedings already taken or orders made, if any, under and by virtue of the said Debtors' Act, but notwithstanding this Act, such proceedings, if any, or any other necessary proceedings under the said Debtors' Act, that may be required to complete, alter or discharge any such proceedings had, or orders made, prior to the coming into force of this Act, may be had and taken as though this Act had not been passed.
