AN ACT TO AUTHORISE ROBERT WOODS TO PRACTICE MEDICINE.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented (praying, by Robert Woods of township forty-nine, range one, Most of the Mifth Meridian to be allowed to practice the profession of Medicine and surgery in the Province of Alberta;

ANT YVYYEAR by evidence accompanying the said petition it appears that the said Robert Woods graduated in medicine from the Western University of London, Ontario, on the sixt day of April, 1895, and received from that Usiversity a diploma as Doctor of Medicine; that the said Robert Woods received from the State of Kansas, one of the United States of America, a certificate of authority to practice medicine and surgery in that State, dated the tventy-second day of August, 1901; and that the said Robert Woods received from the State Board of Health of the State of Missouri, one of the United States of America, a certificate dated the seventeenth day of November, 1898, allowing him to pursue the practice of medicine in that State; and it appearing that the said Robert Woods has now pursued the practice of medicine in the said States of Kansas and Missouri in the United States of America and in Canada for a period covering fifteen years; "And whereas the place in which the petitioner resides is some thirty niles distant from and west of the Town of Leduc; And whereas the said petition is accompanied by a largely signed request of residents of the settlement in which the petitioner resides, praying that the same be granted, more especially as there is no registered practitioner nearer to the said settlement than the form of Leduc aforesaid; And whereas the petitioner asks that an Act be passed to authorise the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta to admit the petitioner to practice as a physician and surgeon in the said Province; And whereas it has been shown that the petitioner is otherwise a proper person to be admitted to practice medicine, and that it is for the benefit of the residents of the settlement that he should be permitted to practice medicine, surgery and midwifery; And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

TVTVVTDER HIS MAJNETY by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta enacts, as follows:

Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta, to include upon the register of the said sollege and to nuthorize the said Robert Woods to pursue the practice of medicine, surgery and midwifery in the said Province of Alberta, and to grant the said Robert Woods such cortificate as may enable him to be admitted to practice the profession of medicine, surgery and midwifery in the said Province of Alberta upon his paying the proper fees in that behalf, without his compliance with the other requirements and provisions of the law or other rules and regulations of the said Coolege of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta in that behalf, any law, custom or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
