An Act to amend the Acts constituting the Medicine Hat
City Charter.

(Assented to _____, 1945.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

The Medicine Hat City Charter, being chapter 63 of the
Statutes of Alberta, 1906, as amended from time to time, is
hereby further amended as follows:

1. As to section 3 of Title XXI by adding as clause (*f*) the
following:

“(f) To inaugurate, establish and provide for a scheme
for pensions and/or retirement allowances for
officers and employees of the City of Medicine Hat,
and to make provision by by-law for the City of
Medicine Hat to become a party to any such scheme
and for the contribution by the City of Medicine Hat
to any fund established pursuant to such scheme,
but no such by-law shall have any force and effect
unless, on the final passing thereof, it shall have
received the assent of sixty per cent of the burgesses
voting thereon; and to empower the City of Medicine
Hat to make deductions from the pay of such officers
and employees appropriate to any scheme for pen-
sions which may be inaugurated, established and
provided.”

2. As to section 13 of Title XXXI by repealing the same,
saving and excepting the rights and obligations accrued
thereunder prior to January 1st, 1945.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which
it is assented to.
