A BILL TO AMEND THE TOWN PLANNING ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends subsection (10) of section 35. This subsection now provides that no plan containing more than ten lots subdivided for selling in allotments shall be registered in a Land Titles Office without an order of the Town and Rural Advisory Board. The amendment makes this restriction apply only where the plan contains more than fifty lots.

H^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Town Planning Act, being chapter 169 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 35 by striking out the words "more than ten lots", where the same occur in subsection (10), and by substituting therefor the words "more than fifty lots".

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
