

Bill No. 36 of 1945.

A BILL TO AMEND THE CHILD WELFARE ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends section 68 by striking out subsections (1) and (2) and substituting a new subsection. As it now stands the section requires the publisher of a periodical before publishing an advertisement dealing with adoption, boarding or care of a child to obtain from the advertiser a memorandum of his name, address and occupation, which must be submitted with the advertisement to the commission for approval. The intention of the amendment is to prohibit the publishing of any advertisement dealing with the adoption of a child.

An Act to amend The Child Welfare Act.

(Assented to _____, 1945.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Child Welfare Act*, being chapter 8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1944, is hereby amended as to section 68,—

(a) by striking out subsections (1) and (2) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

“**68.**—(1) No owner or publisher of any newspaper or magazine published in Alberta shall accept for publication or shall publish any advertisement dealing with the adoption of any child.”

(b) by renumbering subsection (3) thereof as subsection (2).

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
