A BILL TO AMEND THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS
(UNORGANIZED TERRITORY) ACT

NOTE.

Subsection (3) of section 28 which is struck out by section 1 of this Bill required a poundkeeper before entering upon his duties to furnish a bond in the sum of two hundred dollars. This has been found unworkable in practice as it frequently became an impediment to get suitable persons to accept appointments, and it is considered desirable to repeal the provision.

Section 2 of the Bill fixes a new set of fees under the Act and makes them uniform with the fees presented by *The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities)*.

BILL

An Act to amend The Domestic Animals (Unorganized Territory) Act.

(Assented to _____, 1945.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Domestic Animals (Unorganized Territory) Act*, being chapter 92 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 28 by striking out subsection (3) thereof.

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 46,—

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

“(b) To the poundkeeper to provide for the care and sustenance of each animal for each day or fraction of a day such animal is impounded as follows:

For each stallion, bull, jack or boar.....	\$1.00
For each ram or he-goat.....	.35
For each horse, mule, ass, head of cattle or swine50
For each sheep or goat.....	.20
For each goose.....	.10”;

(b) by striking out the figures “25c” where the same occur in paragraph (c) of subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the figures “50c”;

(c) by striking out the figures “\$8” where the same occur in subsection (2) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words “twenty dollars”.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
