A BILL TO AMEND THE VITAL STATISTICS ACT

---

NOTE.

Section 1 of the Bill amends the definition of "Registrar General" to include his deputy so that the latter may perform duties assigned by the Act to the Registrar General.

Section 2 enacts a new section 43a which authorizes the Minister to make an agreement with the Dominion Government to supply statistical information. This is made necessary among other things, in connection with the administration of *The Family Allowances Act*.

# BILL

No. 54 of 1945.

An Act to amend The Vital Statistics Act

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1945.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Vital Statistics Act*, being chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 2 by adding immediately at the end of paragraph (h) thereof the words "and includes the Deputy Registrar-General;"

**2.** The said Act is further amended by adding immediately after section 43 thereof the following new section;

"**43a.** The Minister, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may enter into any arrangement with the Government of Canada or with the Minister in charge of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, to supply to the Government of Canada or the Dominion Bureau of Statistics statistical or other information on such terms, including the amount of charges, if any, to be paid, as may be deemed advisable."

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
