A BILL TO AMEND THE ALBERTA ARCHITECTS ACT

---

NOTE.

Section 10 of the Act which this Bill amends prohibits plans for the erection or alteration of buildings being passed by any authority appointed to pass upon such plans where the cost of the erection or alteration exceeds ten thousand dollars unless the plans have been prepared by or in consultation with a registered or licensed architect. The effect of the proposed amendments is to increase the value of buildings to which the prohibition applies to an amount in excess of twenty thousand dollars, and to exempt private homes from the prohibition without regard to their value.

Section 2 of the Bill changes the maximum fees which the Association may charge its members; the only changes are the second and third fees which are increased from ten dollars and fifteen dollars respectively.

# BILL

No. 58 of 1945.

An Act to amend The Alberta Architects Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1945.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Alberta Architects Act*, being chapter 285 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 10,—

(a) by striking out subsection (5) thereof, and by substituting therefor the following:

“(5) Nothing in this Act shall be construed as preventing the erection by any person on his own property of any building for the sole use of himself and his domestic establishment, nor the planning, designing or supervision by any person of any building to be used as a private home of whatever value it may be, nor of any other building of a value not exceeding twenty thousand dollars.”;

(b) by striking out the words “ten thousand dollars”, where the same occur in subsection (6) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words “twenty thousand dollars”;

(c) by adding immediately after subsection (6) thereof, the following new subsection:

“(6a) The provisions of subsection (6) shall not apply to any building to be used as a private home.”

**2.** The said Act is further amended as to section 16 by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

“**16.** Nothing in this Act shall authorize the Association to impose any fees higher than the following:

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
