No. 2 of 1946.

An Act to amend Chapter 57 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1918, and amendments thereto, being An Act to Incorporate the Calgary and Southwestern Railway Company.

(Assented to _____, 1946.)

WHEREAS the Calgary & Southwestern Railway Company has presented a Petition praying for the amendment of the Act incorporating the said Company, being chapter 57 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1918, as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petition.

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That section 4 of the said Act as the same is amended by section 1 of chapter 74 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1926, be, and the same is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"4. The company may lay out, construct and operate a railway of the gauge of four feet eight and one-half inches, from the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, or from a point at or near the Town of De Winton, on the Calgary & Edmonton Branch of the Canadian Pacific Railway in the said Province by the most feasible route to a point on the western boundary of the said Province in townships sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen or twenty; also from a point on the said railway to the Town of Okotoks on the Calgary and Edmonton Railway."

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
