No. 15 of 1946.

An Act to amend The Department of Education Act.

(Assented to _____, 1946.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Department of Education Act*, being chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 8 by adding immediately after paragraph (a) thereof the following new paragraph:

“(aa) appoint an officer or officers who may from time to time as required examine and inspect all books of record and account, all bank books and all other papers, documents and things pertaining to the business and administration of any school district or school division, which books, papers, documents and things shall be made available on demand to such officer or officers by the officer of the district or division or other person having the custody of them; an officer appointed pursuant to the provisions of this paragraph shall report the result of his inspection to the Minister in the manner prescribed by him;”.

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
