A BILL TO AMEND THE HOME FOR AGED OR
INFIRM ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends the definition of "Home for the aged or infirm" and "Home by the addition of the words set out in section 1. The first portion of the addition is intended to make it clear that the definition applies to a hospital for incurables and the latter portion applies the definition to a portion of an approved hospital set aside for the care of aged or infirm persons.

An Act to amend The Home for Aged or Infirm Act.

(Assented to _____, 1946.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Home for Aged or Infirm Act*, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1945, is hereby amended as to section 2, by adding immediately at the end of paragraph (b) thereof the words "or a hospital which is not an approved hospital within the meaning of *The Hospitals Act*, where three or more aged or infirm persons or incurables are kept for compensation, or a wing or floor of an approved hospital which is wholly reserved for the care of aged or infirm persons".

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
