A BILL TO AMEND THE SOLEMNIZATION OF
MARRIAGE ACT

NOTE.

This Bill adds a proviso to subsection (3) of section 14 of the Act. That subsection requires the production of a doctor's certificate to the effect that he has taken a specimen of blood for a syphilis test from the applicant for the license, etc. The amendment authorizes the acceptance of the certificate of a Provincial District Nurse in lieu of the doctor's certificate in cases where the applicant lives in a remote district far from a physician.

An Act to amend The Solemnization of Marriage Act.

(Assented to _____, 1946.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Solemnization of Marriage Act*, being chapter 303 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 14 by adding immediately at the end of subsection (3) thereof the following proviso:

“Provided, however, that in the case of a person residing at a point where it is impossible to obtain the certificate of a registered physician without great trouble and inconvenience, the issuer or minister or clergyman, as the case may be, may, if satisfied of the foregoing circumstances, accept the certificate of a Provincial District Nurse in lieu of the certificate of a physician.”

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
