A BILL TO AMEND THE AMUSEMENTS ACT

NOTE.

This Bill enacts a new section 18*a* in Part II of the above Act dealing with moving picture operators and authorizes the appointment of an Advisory Board to consult with and advise the Minister as to regulations applicable to such operators.

Section 34 of the Act now provides that in cases which are not dealt with specifically in the Act, the penalty for an infraction of the Act shall be a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars and costs. The amendment strikes out the minimum penalty but the maximum penalty of two hundred dollars and costs still remains.

BILL

An Act to amend The Amusements Act.

(Assented to _____, 1946.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Amusements Act*, being chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 18 thereof the following new section:

“**18a.**—(1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint an Advisory Board consisting of not more than three members whose duty it shall be to consult with and advise the Minister with respect to the regulations relating to moving picture operators and with respect to any proposed amendments thereto.

“(2) The Advisory Board shall meet from time to time on the call of the Minister and its members shall not be entitled to receive any remuneration for their services but shall be entitled to receive out of pocket expenses incurred in attending at meetings of the Board.”

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 34 by striking out the words “not less than twenty-five dollars and costs and” where the same occur therein.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
