#### A BILL RESPECTING THE VILLAGE OF LOMOND

#### NOTE.

The purpose of this Bill is to validate certain changes made in the area included in the Village of Lomond by an order of the Minister of Municipal Affairs dated December 10th, 1929, and effective as of that date. *The Village Act* had, however, been amended some months previously by transferring the authority to make such changes from the Minister to the Board of Public Utility Commissioners, and this amendment had been overlooked. The order has always been considered as effective both by the owners of the lands affected and by the village, and the proposed Bill validates the order.

## BILL

#### No. 36 of 1946.

### An Act Respecting the Village of Lomond.

#### (Assented to

, 1946.)

W HEREAS under the provisions of *The Village Act*, 1927, being chapter 54 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, the Minister of Municipal Affairs was authorized by Order to annex to any village any outlying area adjacent thereto, and not included within the limits of any city or town;

And whereas the boundaries of the Village of Lomond were purported to have been altered, by the annexation of certain lands, under the provisions of an Order of the Minister of Municipal Affairs dated December 10th, 1929, and effective as of that date;

And whereas by reason of an amendment to *The Village Act*, 1927, contained in Chapter 44 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, and effective March 20th, 1929, the said authority of the Minister of Municipal Affairs had been transferred to the Board of Public Utility Commissioners and the Minister had no such authority at the date of the Order;

And whereas the lands affected by the said Order have at all times since the date of the Order been accepted by the village and the owners as being included in the Village and the taxes thereon have been levied and collected by the Village;

And whereas it is considered to be in the public interest that the terms of the Order of the Minister of Municipal Affairs herein referred to be ratified and confirmed;

Now therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Village of Lomond shall, as from the tenth day of December, 1929, be deemed, for all purposes, to have consisted of the following land:

The north-east quarter of Section 14, Township 16, Range 20, west of the Fourth Meridian, and the railway right-ofway and station grounds as shown on Plan R.W. 17 on the west half of Section 13, Township 16, Range 20, west of the Fourth Meridian.

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
