A BILL TO AMEND THE ELECTRIC POWER TAXATION ACT

Under The Electric Power Taxation Act amended by this Bill the assessments are made by the Director of Assessments appointed under The Alberta Municipal Assessment Commission Act and as he is a member of the Alberta Assessment Commission, it is considered desirable that appeals should not go to the Commission but to the Board of Public Utility Commissioners. The amendments made by this Bill are intended to carry that purpose into effect.

An Act to amend The Electric Power Taxation Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Electric Power Taxation Act, being chapter 44 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 3.—
 - (a) by striking out the words "Alberta Assessment Commission", where the same occur in subsection (4) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "Board of Public Utility Commissioners";
 - (b) by striking out subsection (5) thereof, and by substituting therefor the following:
 - "(5) All the provisions of *The Public Utilities* Act, so far as the same are not in conflict with this Act, and the rules and practice of the Board of Public Utility Commissioners as prescribed by and pursuant to *The Public Utilities Act* shall apply to assessments and appeals under this Act to the said Board.";
 - (c) by striking out the words "Alberta Assessment Commission", where the same occur in subsection (6) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "Board of Public Utility Commissioners".
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
