A BILL TO AMEND THE PRIVATE HOSPITALS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends the definition of "private hospital" contained in paragraph (g) of section 2 of the above Act.

The change made in the definition is the elimination of reference to nursing homes and baby shelters. The former is unnecessary and the administration of what were known as baby shelters is provided for in an amendment to *The Child Welfare Act*.

An Act to amend The Private Hospitals Act.

(Assented to _____, 1947).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Private Hospitals Act*, being chapter 186 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 2 by striking out paragraph (g) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

“(g) ‘Private hospital’ means any institution, building, rooms or other place operated by any person for compensation as a place for the reception and treatment of sick persons, and includes maternity homes, but does not include,—

“(i) a hospital receiving public aid under *The Hospitals Act*; or

“(ii) a hospital or other establishment wholly or mainly supported by provincial aid.”

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
