A BILL TO AMEND THE DOMESTIC RELATIONS ACT

NOTE.

The subsection proposed to be amended is in the part dealing with guardianship of children. The provisions relating to adoption of children were formerly in the above Act but are now contained in *The Child Welfare Act* passed in 1944. This amendment is made necessary by that change as the section now in force does not of course refer to adoptions made under *The Child Welfare Act*. The amendment is made retroactive to the date of the passing of *The Child Welfare Act*.

An Act to amend The Domestic Relations Act.

(Assented to _____, 1947).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Domestic Relations Act*, being chapter 300 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 60 by striking out subsection (2) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

“(2) Where a child has been adopted pursuant to the provisions of this Act or of *The Child Welfare Act*, his adoptive father and mother shall be deemed to be his parents within the meaning of this Part.”

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to, and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times since the twenty-fourth day of March, 1944.
