

# BILL

No. 45 of 1947

An Act to amend Chapter 81 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, being an Act to Incorporate the Mennonite Brethren in Christ Church.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1947.)

WHEREAS the Mennonite Brethren in Christ Church has presented a petition praying for the amendment of the Act incorporating the said Church, being chapter 81 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The said Act is amended by adding as section 9a immediately after section 9 the following:

“9a.—(1) All the real property described as follows:

The whole of block four (4), plan 7976 C.N. and lot four (4) in block four (4), plan 4191 F.P. in the Townsite of Didsbury and the personal property situated thereon shall while registered in the name of the corporation and owned by it and while used by it for or in connection with educational purposes of a theological nature be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments of any nature and kind, save and except special frontage assessment taxes under *The Town and Village Act*.

“(2) Such exemption from taxation shall for all purposes be deemed to have existed since the 1st day of January, A.D. 1947.

“(3) The corporation shall, as of the 1st day of January, A.D. 1947, be responsible for its own medical and hospitalization services, and no responsibility therefor shall fall upon or be committed to either the Town of Didsbury or the Municipal District of Mountain View No. 49.”

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
