Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour J. C. Bowen, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-six, the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, and the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, 1947."
- 2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole ninety-two thousand, four hundred and thirty-four dollars and seventy-four cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-six, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.
- 3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole two million, four hundred and twenty-four thousand, one hundred and six dollars and eighty-eight cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine

hundred and forty-six to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

- 4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole fifty-one million, four hundred and fifty-two thousand, seven hundred and thirty-four dollars towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule C to this Act.
- 5. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
- 6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
