HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Social Services Tax Act, being chapter 56 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby repealed as from the first day of January, 1947.
- 2. Notwithstanding such repeal, the said Act shall be deemed to be and continue to be in force for the purpose of enforcing any right or remedy now or heretofore accruing or accrued under it.
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
