An Act to amend The Society of Industrial Accounts of Alberta Act, 1944.

(Assented to , 1948.)

WHEREAS the Society of Industrial Accountants of Alberta incorporated under *The Society of Industrial* Accountants of Alberta Act, 1944, has by its petition represented that it is desirous of changing its name to The Society of Industrial and Cost Accountants of Alberta;

And whereas the said Society has prayed that an Act may be passed for such purpose;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Now therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Society of Industrial Accounts of Alberta Act, 1944, is hereby amended as to the long title thereof by striking out the words "The Society of Industrial Accountants of Alberta", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "The Society of Industrial and Cost Accountants of Alberta".

2. the said Act is further amended as to the preamble thereto by striking out the words "The Society of Industrial Accountants of Alberta", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "The Society of Industrial and Cost Accountants of Alberta".

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 1 by striking out the words "The Society of Industrial Accountants of Alberta", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "The Society of Industrial and Cost Accountants of Alberta".

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 16 thereof by striking out the words "The Society of Industrial Accountants of Alberta Act, 1944", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "The Society of Industrial and Cost Accountants of Alberta Act".

5. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
