A BILL TO AMEND THE PIPE LINE ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Pipe Line Act*.

Section 11 (1) (o) is amended by the Bill to make it applicable to Crown Lands as well as to private lands.

The Pipe Line Act provides that a pipe line company which has obtained a permit may acquire Crown and private lands required for its right-of-way. By section 11 the Board of Public Utility Commissioners is authorized to make orders respecting the taking and use of lands required for the right-of-way. The effect of the amendment is that such orders may be made which apply to Crown lands as well as to private lands.

An Act to amend The Pipe Line Act.

(Assented to _____, 1948.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Pipe Line Act*, being chapter 315 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 11 by striking out the words "of any land or interest therein which is not the property of the company, and the method of ascertaining the amount of any compensation to be paid to the persons", where the same occur in paragraph (o) of subsection (1) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "of Crown lands or any other lands or interest therein which is not the property of the company and the method of ascertaining the amount of any compensation to be paid to the Crown or other persons".

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
