### Bill No. 27 of 1948.

### A BILL TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL AUDITORS ACT

### NOTE.

This Bill amends The Official Auditors Act.

Two new sections are added to the Act, the first of which provides that an application for an appointment as an official auditor shall be accompanied by a fee of one dollar.

Section 6 provides that all appointments as official auditors made prior to the thirty-first day of January, 1948, shall expire on the thirty-first day of January, 1949, and all subsequent appointments shall expire on the third thirtyfirst day of January following the date upon which the appointment was made.

# BILL

### No. 27 of 1948.

An Act to amend The Official Auditors Act.

### (Assented to , 1948.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Official Auditors Act, being chapter 26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 4 thereof the following new sections:

**"5.** Every application for an appointment as an official auditor shall be accompanied by a fee of one dollar.

"6. Every appointment of an official auditor made prior to the thirty-first day of January, 1948, shall expire on the thirty-first day of January, 1949, and every other appointment of an official auditor shall expire on the third thirtyfirst day of January following the date upon which the appointment was made.".

**2.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
