

Bill No. 27 of 1948.

A BILL TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL AUDITORS ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Official Auditors Act*.

Two new sections are added to the Act, the first of which provides that an application for an appointment as an official auditor shall be accompanied by a fee of one dollar.

Section 6 provides that all appointments as official auditors made prior to the thirty-first day of January, 1948, shall expire on the thirty-first day of January, 1949, and all subsequent appointments shall expire on the third thirty-first day of January following the date upon which the appointment was made.

An Act to amend The Official Auditors Act.

(Assented to _____, 1948.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Official Auditors Act*, being chapter 26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 4 thereof the following new sections:

“**5.** Every application for an appointment as an official auditor shall be accompanied by a fee of one dollar.

“**6.** Every appointment of an official auditor made prior to the thirty-first day of January, 1948, shall expire on the thirty-first day of January, 1949, and every other appointment of an official auditor shall expire on the third thirty-first day of January following the date upon which the appointment was made.”.

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
