**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Employment Offices Act*, being chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby repealed.

**2.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
