HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Old Age Pensions (Supplementary Allowances) Act, being Chapter 270 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 3 by striking out the word "five", where the same occurs therein, and by substituting therefor the word "seven".
- **2.** The said Act is further amended as to section 4a by striking out the word "five", where the same occurs therein, and by substituting therefor the word "seven".
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
