A BILL TO AMEND THE CHANGE OF NAME ACT

---

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Change of Name Act*, being chapter 328 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 4 is amended. This section requires every applicant for a change of name to file certain documents with the Provincial Secretary. Those persons who were naturalized prior to the passage of *The Canadian Citizenship Act* are required to file a certified copy of their naturalization certificate. The purpose of the amendment is to provide that those persons who become Canadian citizens under the provisions of *The Canadian Citizenship Act* will file a certified copy of their certificate of Canadian citizenship.

# BILL

An Act to amend The Change of Name Act.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Change of Name Act*, being chapter 328 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 4 by adding immediately at the end of paragraph (c) thereof, the words "or a certified copy of the certificate of Canadian citizenship by virtue of which the applicant claims to be a Canadian citizen".

**2.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
