### A BILL TO AMEND THE RETIREMENT PENSION ACT

This Bill amends The Retirement Pension Act, being chapter 12 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948.

Section 7 (d) is amended by adding at the end of that paragraph the following words "multiplied by the total number of years of his pensionable service". These words were omitted from the original draft through an oversight. The amendment is made retroactive to the date of coming into force of the Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Retirement Pension Act, being chapter 12 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948, is hereby amended as to section 7 by adding immediately at the end of paragraph (d) thereof the words "multiplied by the total number of years of his pensionable service".
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to, and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times since the thirty-first day of March, 1948.
