# A BILL TO AMEND THE CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT ACT

#### NOTE.

This Bill amends The Cultural Development Act, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946.

Section 7 of the Act is struck out and a new section is substituted. Under the old section members of a board could only be paid their actual out-of-pocket expenses. Members of these boards receive no remuneration and they are frequently away from their businesses or places of employment while voluntarily engaged on the work of their board. It is desirable that provision should be made to compensate them to some degree for the services they render by authorizing the payment of subsistence to them while they are engaged on the work of the board. The amended section provides that the Lieutenant Governor in Council may from time to time authorize the payment of such subsistence allowances and travelling expenses as may be deemed proper and expedient.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Cultural Development Act, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946, is hereby amended as to section 7 by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:
- "7. (1) The members of a board shall receive no remuneration for their services, but the Lieutenant Governor in Council may from time to time by regulation authorize the payment of such subsistence allowances, travelling expenses and other expenses as may be deemed proper and expedient in connection with the attendance of board members at board meetings or their duties while otherwise engaged in the work of any board.
- "(2) All payments authorized by this section to the members of any board shall be made out of the funds of that board, or out of moneys appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose."
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
