

Bill No. 25 of 1949.

A BILL TO AMEND THE TRUSTEE ACT

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NOTE.

This Bill repeals sections 59 and 60 of *The Trustee Act*, being chapter 215 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Sections 59 and 60 of *The Trustee Act* are no longer a necessary part of that Act in as much as the sections being repealed have been incorporated in *The Public Trustee Act*, a new Act which is intended to consolidate in one Act provisions which were formerly found in *The Official Guardian Act*, *The Estates of the Mentally Incompetent Act*, *The Judicature Act* and *The Trustee Act*.

The date of coming into force of the Act is fixed for the first day of July, 1949, because *The Public Trustee Act* comes into force on that date.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,  
enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Trustee Act*, being chapter 215 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to sections 59 and 60 by striking out the same.

**2.** This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, 1949.
