

Bill No. 43 of 1949.

A BILL TO AMEND THE LAND CLEARING AND
BREAKING PROJECTS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Land Clearing and Breaking Projects Act*, being chapter 11 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948.

Section 2 of the Act is amended to bring it within the purview of the Minister of Lands and Forests and the Department of Lands and Forests.

Section 6 is amended so that it will refer to *The Public Lands Act* which replaces *The Provincial Lands Act*.

This Act comes into force on the first day of April, 1949, because that is the date on which the new Department of Lands and Forests and the new Department of Mines come into existence.

An Act to amend The Land Clearing and Breaking Projects Act.

(Assented to _____, 1949.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Land Clearing and Breaking Projects Act*, being chapter 11 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948, is hereby amended as to section 2 by striking out the words "and Mines" wherever the same occur therein and by substituting the words "and Forests".

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 6 by striking out the words "*The Provincial Lands Act*" and by substituting the words "*The Public Lands Act*".

3. This Act shall come into force on the first day of April, 1949.
