

Bill No. 60 of 1949.

A BILL TO AMEND THE OIL AND GAS WELLS ACT.

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NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Oil and Gas Wells Act*, being chapter 67 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 3, subsection (1), paragraph (a) is amended. The Department of Lands and Mines is being divided into two new Departments and this amendment is necessary because the Minister of Mines and Minerals is taking over the administration of this Act.

This Bill comes into force on the first day of April, 1949, which is the date the division of the Department becomes effective.

# BILL

No. 60 of 1949.

An Act to amend The Oil and Gas Wells Act.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Oil and Gas Wells Act*, being chapter 67 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 3 by striking out the words "Lands and Mines" where they occur in paragraph (a) of subsection (1), and by substituting the words "Mines and Minerals".

**2.** This Act shall come into force on the first day of April, 1949.
