A BILL TO AMEND THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS
ACT (MUNICIPALITIES).

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities)*, being chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 44 of the Act is amended by increasing the charges which a poundkeeper is entitled to collect on account of animals impounded.

Section 58 is amended by increasing the fees payable to a poundkeeper in respect of the sale of any impounded animals.

The Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

An Act to amend The Domestic Animals Act
(Municipalities).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities)*, being
chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby
amended as to section 44,—

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1),
and by substituting the following:

“(b) To the poundkeeper to provide for the care
and sustenance of such animal for each day or
fraction thereof such animal is impounded as
follows:

For each Stallion, bull, jack or boar.....	\$2.00
For each ram or he-goat50
For each horse, mule, ass, head of cattle or swine.....	1.00
For each sheep or goat.....	.40
For each goose.....	.20;”

(b) by striking out the words “fifty cents” where they
occur in paragraph (c) of subsection (1) and by
substituting the words “one dollar”;

(c) by striking out the words “twenty-five cents” where
they occur in paragraph (d) of subsection (1) and
by substituting the words “fifty cents”.

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 58,—

(a) by striking out the words “one dollar” wherever
they occur in paragraphs (a), (e) and (f) and by
substituting the words “two dollars”;

(b) by striking out the words “fifty cents” where they
occur in paragraph (c) and by substituting the
words “one dollar”.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which
it is assented to.
