A BILL TO AMEND THE LLOYDMINSTER
HOSPITAL ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Lloydminster Hospital Act*, being chapter 19 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948.

Sections 42 and 46 of the Act are amended so that instead of it being necessary to post the notices referred to in at least two widely separated places and in all post offices, it is now necessary to post the notices in at least three widely separated places in each polling division.

This amendment is rendered necessary by the ruling of the Postmaster General that the consent of a Post Office Inspector must be obtained before a notice may be posted in a post office. This consent cannot always be obtained so the mandatory requirement is being removed from the Act.

An Act to amend The Lloydminster Hospital Act.

(Assented to _____, 1949.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Lloydminster Hospital Act*, being chapter 19 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948, is hereby amended as to section 42,—

- (a) by striking out the word “two” and by substituting the word “three”;
- (b) by striking out the words “and also in all post offices, if any, in the Hospital District”.

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 46,—

- (a) by striking out the word “two” and by substituting the word “three”;
- (b) by striking out the words “and also in all post offices in such municipality or electoral division”.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
