### A BILL TO AMEND THE GAOLS AND PRISONS ACT.

#### Note.

This Bill amends *The Gaols and Prisons Act*, being chapter 127 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

The administration of prisons and gaols was transferred from the Department of Public Works to the Department of the Attorney General by Order in Council passed under the authority of section 8 of *The Public Service Act* on May 19th, 1948.

Section 8 of *The Gaols and Prisons Act* is accordingly amended to refer to the Attorney General rather than the Minister of Public Works.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Gaols and Prisons Act, being chapter 127 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 8 by striking out the words "Minister of Public Works", where they occur therein, and by substituting the words "Attorney General".
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
