

Bill No. 103 of 1949.

A BILL TO AMEND THE WATER USERS' DISTRICTS
ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Water Users' Districts Act*, being chapter 105 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 7 (1) of the Act is amended by deleting the reference to a post office because, as a result of instructions issued by the Postmaster-General the consent of a Post Office Inspector must now be obtained before a notice may be posted in a post office. This consent cannot always be obtained so the mandatory requirement is being removed from this section of the Act.

The Act is to come into force on the day on which it is assented to.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Water Users' Districts Act*, being chapter 105 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 7 by striking out the words "and in the post office therein or nearest thereto" where they occur in subsection (1).

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
