

Bill No. 121 of 1949.

A BILL RESPECTING TRANS-CANADA HIGHWAYS

NOTE

This Bill enacts a new Act to be known as "The Trans-Canada Highways Act".

The Act enables the Lieutenant Governor in Council to enter into an agreement with the Government of the Dominion providing for the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of trans-Canada highways and providing for the payment by Alberta of a portion of the cost incurred.

The Lieutenant Governor in Council is authorized to expend moneys not exceeding a total of two million dollars under any such agreement.

The Minister of Public Works is responsible for putting into effect the provisions of this Act.

An Act Respecting Trans Canada Highways

(Assented to . 1949.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Short Title

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Trans Canada Highways Act"
- 2 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may from time to time.
 - (a) enter into an agreement with the Government of the Dominion providing for the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of trans Canada highways and providing for the payment by Alberta of a portion of the costs incurred in constructing, reconstructing and maintaining trans Canada highways in so far as they may be within the Province;
 - (b) do all things necessary or expedient to carry out the said agreement in conjunction with the Government of the Dominion and in particular may institute and carry out such measures as may from time to time be considered practicable and necessary for the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of trans Canada highways in so far as they may be within the Province;
 - (c) expend moneys not exceeding a total of two million dollars in 1949 under any such agreement for the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of trans Canada highways in so far as they may be within the Province;
 - (d) make such regulations as are deemed necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act according to their true intent
- 3 (1) All moneys expended under this Act shall be paid out of any moneys that may be appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose and in default

of any such appropriation may be paid out of the General Revenue Fund.

(2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall have power to raise by way of loan any sum or sums of money that may be necessary to discharge the obligation of the Province under this Act.

4. For the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this Act the Minister of Public Works shall be charged with its administration.

5. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
