An Act to provide for the Celebration of the Founding of
Calgary.

(Assented to _____, 1950.).

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Calgary has presented a Petition to the Legislature of the Province of Alberta for the passing of a Bill to enable the City to raise by way of taxation the sum of not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the purpose of organizing and carrying out a fitting celebration of the Seventy-fifth Anniversary of the founding of the City of Calgary;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The City of Calgary is hereby empowered to raise by way of taxation, either by inclusion in its annual Estimates for the year 1950 or in any other way permitted by its charter provisions, an amount not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the purpose of organizing and carrying out a fitting celebration of the Seventy-fifth Anniversary of the founding of the City of Calgary.

This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
