# A BILL TO AMEND THE OLD AGE PENSIONS (SUPPLEMENTARY ALLOWANCES) ACT.

### NOTE.

This Bill amends The Old Age Pensions (Supplementary Allowances) Act, being chapter 270 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 3 is amended to make it clear that the supplementary allowances payable by the Province to old age pensioners for the period from the first of June, 1949, to the thirty-first of March, 1950, were seven dollars and fifty cents per month, and that thereafter the supplementary allowances payable will be ten dollars per month.

The Bill is retroactive to June 1st, 1949, which was the date upon which payment of supplementary allowances of seven dollars and fifty cents per month was commenced.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Old Age Pensions (Supplementary Allowances) Act, being chapter 270 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 3 by striking out the words "the sum of ten dollars per month" and by substituting the words "a supplementary allowance of seven dollars and fifty cents per month from the first day of June, 1949, to the thirty-first day of March, 1950, and thereafter a supplementary allowance of ten dollars per month".
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of June, 1949.
