

Bill No. 17 of 1950.

A BILL TO AMEND THE ALBERTA EVIDENCE ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Alberta Evidence Act*, being chapter 106 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 36 (2) is amended. The amendment increases the fee payable for obtaining copies of public documents or records from ten cents to twenty cents per folio of one hundred words. This fee has not been changed for thirty years and the new fee approximately equals the cost of having the copies prepared.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta Evidence Act*, being chapter 106 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 36, subsection (2) by striking out the word "ten" and by substituting the word "twenty".

2. This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, 1950.
