A BILL TO AMEND THE CEMETERY ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Cemetery Act*, being chapter 256 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2 of the Act is amended. The proposed amendment would enable persons owning plots in existing cemeteries to incorporate a company for the purpose of taking over the cemetery without the necessity of first subscribing twenty-five percent of the capital stock of the proposed company. At present they are unable to do so.

An Act to amend The Cemetery Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Cemetery Act, being chapter 256 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 2,—
 - (a) by renumbering the same as subsection (1);
 - (b) by adding immediately after the word and figure "section 4" where they occur in clause (b) of subsection (1), the words "and deposited the instrument, or a duplicate thereof, in the office of the Provincial Secretary";
 - (c) by striking out clause (d) of subsection (1) and by substituting the following:
 - "(d) deposited in the office of the Provincial Secretary a certificate of the treasurer that there has been paid to the treasurer twenty-five per cent of the capital stock intended to be raised.".
 - (d) by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following new subsection:
 - "(2) A company which is being formed for the purpose of taking over an existing cemetery shall not be required to comply with the provisions of clauses (c) and (d) of subsection (1).".
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, 1950.
