A BILL TO AMEND THE AMUSEMENTS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Amusements Act*, being chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Schedule A to the Act is amended. The amendment is designed to bring amusement tax charges for boxing and wrestling exhibitions in line with amusement tax charges for other forms of entertainment. Under the Act as it now reads the amount charged is greater than that charged for other forms of entertainment.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Amusements Act, being chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to Schedule A,—
 - (a) by striking out clause (12);
 - (b) by renumbering clauses (13) and (14) as clauses (12) and (13).
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, 1950.
