A BILL TO AMEND THE TRANS-CANADA  
HIGHWAYS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Trans-Canada Highways Act*, being chapter 101 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1949.

Section 2(c) is amended. This clause authorizes the Lieutenant Governor in Council to expend moneys not exceeding two million dollars in 1949 for the construction and maintenance of trans-Canada highways. The effect of the amendment is to extend the time for the expenditure of these moneys for a further period of one year.

An Act to amend The Trans-Canada Highways Act.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Trans-Canada Highways Act*, being chapter 101 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1949, is hereby amended as to section 2, clause (c) by striking out the figures "1949" and by substituting the figures "1950".

**2.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
