

Bill No. 11 of 1951.

A BILL TO AMEND THE POWER COMMISSION ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Power Commission Act*, being chapter 5 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1944.

Subsection (1) of section 24 is struck out and a new subsection is substituted. The effect of the amendment is to change the period covered by the annual report from the year ending the thirty-first of March to the year ending on the thirty-first of December. As a result of the amendment a report can be tabled in the Legislative Assembly covering the immediately preceding calendar year. Under the present section a report cannot be tabled until it is approximately a year old.

An Act to amend The Power Commission Act.

(Assented to _____, 1951.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Power Commission Act*, being chapter 5 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1944, is hereby amended.

2. Section 24 is amended by striking out subsection (1) and by substituting the following: Section 24 amended

“24.—(1) The Commission shall make an annual report to the Minister covering the twelve months’ period ending on the thirty-first day of December in each year and showing,— Annual report

- (a) its revenues and expenditures for the period;
- (b) a complete statement of its reserve funds;
- (c) an audited balance sheet of its financial transactions for the period;
- (d) such other information as the Lieutenant Governor in Council requires.”.

3. This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, 1951. Coming into force
