

Bill No. 14 of 1951.

A BILL TO AMEND THE PUBLIC WORKS
DEPARTMENT ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Public Works Department Act*, being chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 25 of the Act provides that the Provincial Treasurer may, upon requisition of the Minister of Public Works, advance out of the General Revenue Fund sums required for equipment, stock and material required by the Government not to exceed at any one time the sum of three million dollars. The effect of the amendment is to increase this maximum by seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars to a total of three million seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

The amendment is made retroactive to the twenty-ninth day of May, 1950, on which date O.C. 624-50 was passed, subject to the enactment of a retroactive amendment to this effect being enacted at this session of the Legislature.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Public Works Department Act*, being chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 25 is amended by adding immediately after the words "three million", where they occur in the proviso, the words "seven hundred and fifty thousand". Section 25 amended

3. This Act shall come into force on the twenty-ninth day of May, 1950. Coming into force
