A BILL TO AMEND THE EDUCATION OF THE CHILDREN OF DECEASED AND DISABLED SERVICE MEN'S ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends The Education of the Children of Deceased and Disabled Service Men's Act, being chapter 8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946.

The short title is amended by changing the name of the Act to "The Education of Service Men's Children Act".

Sections 2 and 3 are amended. This Act now provides secondary educational facilities for the children of service men who died or were disabled as the result of war service in World War II, and who were resident in the Province at the time of their enlistment. The amendments to these two sections extend the Act to cover the children of deceased and disabled service men who served in World War I.

The Bill comes into force upon assent.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Education of the Children of Deceased and Disabled Service Men's Act, being chapter 8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946, is hereby amended.

2. Section 1 is amended by striking out the words "The short title Education of the Children of Deceased and Disabled Service amended Men's Act" and by substituting the words "The Education of Service Men's Children Act".

3. Section 2 is amended,—

Section 2 amended

- (a) by striking out the words "first day of September," 1939," and by substituting the words "fourth day of August, 1914,";
- (b) by adding immediately after the words "full time service" the words "in World War I or".

4. Section 3 is amended by adding immediately after section 3 the words "enlisted for service" the words "in World War I or".

5. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which Coming into force it is assented to.
