### REPRINTED BILL

#### Bill No. 18 of 1951.

#### A BILL TO AMEND THE BRAND ACT.

#### NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Brand Act*, being chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

A new section 7a is added immediately after section 7. It provides that the cattle brand "B" on the right jaw shall be reserved exclusively to designate brucellosis infected cattle, and that the cattle brand "T" on the left jaw shall be reserved exclusively to designate tuberculosis infected cattle. These brands do not give rise to any presumption of ownership. Only the veterinary conducting the brucellosis or tuberculosis tests may order the branding with the brands named in this section.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1951.

## BILL

#### No. 18 of 1951.

#### An Act to amend The Brand Act.

#### (Assented to , 1951.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Brand Act, being chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. The following new section 7a is added immediately New section 7aafter section 7:

"7 $\alpha$ .—(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this Act,— Brands for

- "(a) the cattle brand 'B' on the right jaw shall be re-tuberculosis served exclusively to designate brucellosis infected cattle cattle as provided in section 3e of The Live Stock Diseases Act and in the Animal Contagious Diseases Act of Canada;
- "(b) the cattle brand 'T' on the left jaw shall be reserved exclusively to designate tuberculosis infected cattle as provided in the Animal Contagious Diseases Act of Canada;
- "(c) the cattle brand 'B' on the right jaw and the cattle brand 'T' on the left jaw shall not give rise to any presumption of ownership.

"(2) Only the veterinarian conducting the brucellosis or tuberculosis tests may brand or order the branding of brucellosis or tuberculosis reacting cattle with the brands named in this section.

"(3) The cattle brand 'B' on the right jaw and the cattle Brands brand 'T' on the left jaw shall be permanently recorded by recorded the recorder of brands for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1).".

3. This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, Coming into force 1951.
