A BILL TO AMEND THE DOMESTIC RELATIONS  
ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Domestic Relations Act*, being chapter 300 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 26, subsection (2) is amended. This section enables a married woman who is deserted by her husband to apply to a police magistrate for a maintenance order. The magistrate may order the husband to pay a weekly sum for the maintenance of his wife and family not exceeding twenty dollars. The effect of the amendment is to enable the magistrate to order the payment of thirty dollars instead of twenty dollars.

An Act to amend The Domestic Relations Act.

(*Assented to* , 1951.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Domestic Relations Act*, being chapter 300 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 26, subsection (2) is amended by striking out the word “twenty” and by substituting the word “thirty”. <sup>Section 26 amended</sup>

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, <sup>Coming into force</sup> 1951.
